



April 11, 2024 MINUTES

Libby called the meeting to order at 6:00 P.M with an opening prayer.

MINUTES: Handwritten minutes were saved to the Home & School Drive for March's meeting.

TREASURER: Open House cost (\$48). St. Patrick's Day sucker sales brought in approximately \$100. Egg Hunt cost of (\$245). Current balance is approximately \$4,200.

OLD BUSINESS: Movie Night – April 19th: Movie will be Ratatouille. Same concessions items as previously with donations accepted, Kayla Carlson will do the shopping for the event. Kaylyn and Kayla agreed to bag up the cotton candy before the event. We still need about 10 volunteers in the kitchen and chaperones – Beth, Kayla and Miranda all stated they are able to volunteer if the spots don't fill.

Secretary's Day – April 24th: Sarah Windbiel will have some decorations and a gift basket to celebrate Mrs. Sara!

Principal's Day – May 1st: Molly to work with Sara to have Dress like a Principal added to the May calendar. Libby will work on a gift basket to celebrate Mr. Muhs. Teachers will work with students to trace their hand and have students list their favorite thing about Mr. Muhs, a note to Mr. Muhs or a picture, etc. Each grade will have a different color paper to use. Teachers to get hand prints to Libby by April 26th to decorate Mike's office.

Spring Auction Kids Area: Spring Auction Kids Carnival will be held on May 3rd from 4:30 – 8:00 PM. We are still in need of about 25 volunteers for the kids area. Sabra is checking with Menominee Public Schools for volunteers. Mrs. Doubek is checking with STAA. Libby will reach to last years volunteers. Molly will reach to Josh Jones with YAC for volunteers. Bridget compiled a list of leftover prizes which was minimal. We approved \$100 to be spent at the Dollar Store for prizes – let us know if you are interested in volunteering for this.

Hot Lunch: Our May lunch will actually be a bring your own cold lunch picnic outside with 15 minute extended recess for our Teacher's to be able to enjoy their Teacher Appreciation luncheon. All volunteer spots have been filled and these volunteers will supervise the outside lunch and recess as well as hand out ice cream bars which Home & School will sponsor. Beth will handle purchasing 132 ice cream bars from Walmart costing approximately \$40.

End of Year Picnic – June 5th: Molly posted to Facebook looking for ideas for the End of Year Picnic which included Ice Cloud Truck, Dunk Tank and Photobooth. Molly looked into Ice Cloud trucks but they are for sale, Molly sent an inquiry to Dough Shop truck. Last year when we reached to the local ice cream truck prices were approximately \$4 per student (\$520). Jakes Jumpers has a Dunk Tank available for \$345. Memories Studios has a photo booth with printed strips available for \$350.

Ideas brought up at the meeting were field games including a Gaga Ball tournament, making our own photo booth, ice cream sundae bar, having student t-shirts made for signatures, pie in the face. It was agreed that most families will want to participate with their students that day so volunteers will be hard to find. Libby is going to reach out to Mischief & Magic to see if they have any availability. Molly will reach out to Geoff/Bubble Wonder. Libby will then send a vote via GroupMe for choosing. Our budget for the day is \$1,500. Formal dismissal will take place at 11:30 AM, so we will plan to eat around 11 AM.

Marketing Committee is working on having stickers with JPII logo on the waterbottles as well as slips stapled to the popcorn bags. Molly will create a sign up for volunteers.
