OLD BUSINESS: Vice President Position: The Vice President positions remains open as we have had no one come forward with interest. Molly will get it added to NYCU again following Christmas. Election of Officers begins in March.

Hot Lunch: December hot lunch went well – everyone was given a Christmas cookie, even if they did not partake in hot lunch. Dominoe's was wonderful to work with once again and provided a discount. We discussed students being tired of pizza staff has requested our January hot lunch be a pancake lunch during Catholic Schools Week. We will host this hot lunch on Wednesday, January 31st with pancakes, sausages, yogurt and fruit cups. February hot lunch will be moved a week later to February 21st due to Ash Wednesday. Mrs. Mielke will be hosting March hot lunch, Molly to send her the current sign-up list.

Christmas Program: The Christmas Play/Program will take place on December 20th. We will once again serve baked goods and hot chocolate following the program. Hot chocolate will be provided by Home & School, flyers requesting baked goods were sent home and included in News You Can Use. We are still looking for 1 additional volunteer to help replenish the baked goods table. Melissa Kowalski Photography will set up at the end of the program along the South East wall of the gym. Santa will join for pictures as well.

Catholic Schools Week: Home & School has been working with the faculty/staff to plan Catholic School's week student activities. All area schools are short on bus drivers, we are waiting on confirmation of availability from Menominee and Stephenson before confirming the weeks activities.

Home & School has agreed to collaborate with the faculty/staff/students on a Parish Appreciation Breakfast which will take place 9:00 AM – Noon at Resurrection on January 28th. Cost of the breakfast will be split between Home & School and the Schools general fund. In years past there has been approximately 150 attendees.
